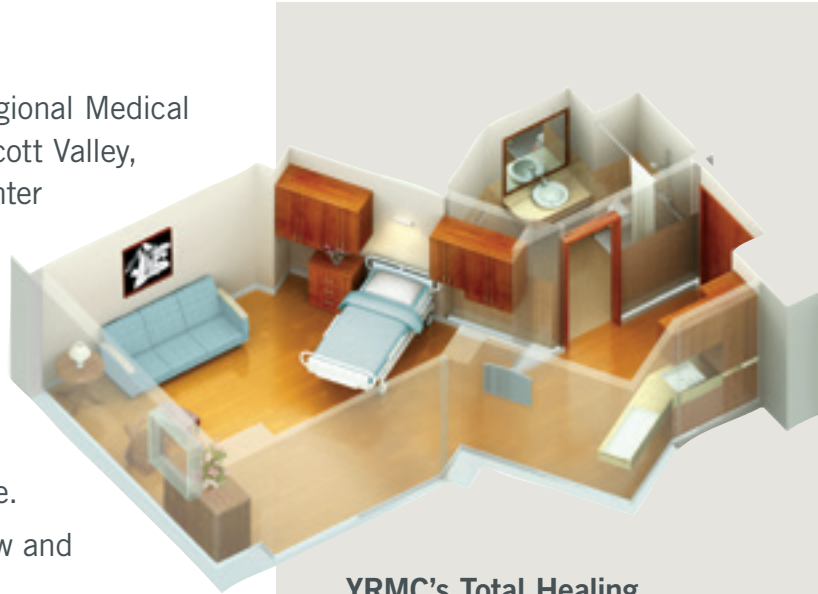

Located on Dignity Health, Yavapai Regional Medical Center's (YRMC) East Campus in Prescott Valley, our state-of-the-art Family Birthing Center features services, programs and experts to help you before, during and following delivery.

Here's a look at how you benefit from the Family Birthing Center's blend of top technology and compassionate care.

- Prenatal education programs for new and experienced parents.
- Family support before, during and following delivery.
- 16 private, spacious rooms, each with a garden view.
- Exceptional obstetrical nurses and dedicated providers.
- Couplet care so you and your baby can stay together in the same room during those first cherished hours (The Respite Nursery is available for babies when moms need to rest).
- The latest technology and equipment, including dedicated cesarean-section operating suites.
- A Level II Continuing Care Nursery licensed by the Arizona Department of Health Services (ADHS) – and certified by the Arizona Perinatal Trust – to care for high-risk newborns and their moms.
- Private triage rooms and outpatient testing areas.

Making Memories at the Family Birthing Center

We understand and appreciate that the birthing experience is rich with memories that will last a lifetime. That's why we've taken special care to ensure the Family Birthing Center enhances those precious memories by featuring:

- Private labor, delivery, recovery and postpartum (LDRP) rooms that include large private bathrooms.
- Patient rooms set up for “couplet care” so baby and mom can stay together.
- Patient rooms that maximize privacy (delivery beds are not visible from the hallway).
- A comfortable sleeper/sofa for dad or coach in each room.
- Special areas for family and friends to visit in the Family Birthing Center.

Other amenities you'll find in each Family Birthing Center patient room:

- Wireless Internet service.
- A TV/DVD unit.
- A small refrigerator.
- Room service so you can dine together.

And because your baby's health is our priority, the Family Birthing Center also features:

- Two dedicated, state-of-the-art cesarean-section operating suites.
- Six private triage rooms.
- Two nursery areas.

Serving Mom and Baby

Protecting the health of moms and babies has always been the top priority of Dignity Health, YRMC's Family Birthing Center – a priority that begins before your baby's birth and continues after. We do this with fun, informative and free – or moderately priced – classes taught by professionals from YRMC's Family Birthing Center.

Family Birth Classes

Who should join: First-time moms and their partners.

What you'll learn: Learn about relaxation, pain coping strategies, what to expect at the hospital as well as basic infant care.

When classes take place: Two-hour sessions held weekly for four weeks. An eight-hour class is also offered once a month on a Saturday (you should begin Family Birth Classes no later than the 27th week of pregnancy).

Breastfeeding Works!

Who should join: Mothers and partners who have made the decision to breastfeed their newborn.

What you'll learn: A YRMC lactation consultant offers information and instruction on breastfeeding.

When classes take place: A single four-hour class on the second Saturday of the month.

Providing a Higher-Level of Care

Babies born too early or considered medically high risk receive specialized care through the Family Birthing Center's Level II Continuing Care Nursery. Licensed by the Arizona Department of Health Services (ADHS), our Continuing Care Nursery also has earned certification from the Arizona Perinatal Trust. This means Family Birthing Center nurses who care for newborns in our Continuing Care Nursery are prepared for all aspects of neonatal care.

Arizona Perinatal Trust Mission: The Arizona Perinatal Trust is created to be an independent source of energy and resource to focus efforts on the continuing improvement of the health of Arizona's mothers and babies.

Arizona Perinatal Trust Vision: Thus, the critical impact of birth outcome, which persists for the duration of each life, calls for special commitment to the principle of equal access to high-quality care for all mothers and their babies.

Visitation Guidelines

Visiting hours are from 10:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. Hours are unrestricted during the labor process. The designated significant other or coach may visit 24-hours-a-day.

Guests are limited to four. Additional guests may wait in the designated reception areas. All guests must sign-in and out at the Family Birthing Center control desk. Children must be 12 years of age or older, unless they are siblings of the newborn.

To protect our patients and staff, guests with symptoms of a cold, respiratory infection or any illness should not visit the Family Birthing Center.
