- Support group



Our State-of-the-Art Screening and Diagnostic Technology

Dignity Health, YRMC's Breast Care Center provides the latest imaging technology. Working closely with your physician, our team recommends the most effective state-of-the-art application for your individual needs. Our experienced radiologists interpret all Breast Care Center studies and provide results to your physician through YRMC's secure and fast Electronic Medical Record (EMR) system.

Here's our menu of advanced breast imaging and diagnostic services:

- **Breast MRI** – Designed especially for breast imaging, a physician may recommend a breast MRI after a suspicious finding from a mammogram, ultrasound or physical exam. After a positive biopsy, breast MRI also may be used to check all of the breast tissue.
- **Breast Ultrasound** – This diagnostic tool uses sound waves to produce images of breast tissue. Breast ultrasound may be recommended after a suspicious mammogram finding or if there are symptoms, such as breast tenderness or a lump.
- **Core Needle Biopsy** – During this procedure, a physician uses a computer image-guided tool to biopsy a lump in the breast. Core needle biopsy is used both for lumps noticeable during clinical breast exams as well as to biopsy suspicious areas only visible on imaging tests.
- **Digital Mammography** – The Breast Care Center's digital mammography units meet the high standards set by the American College of Radiology. Our

mammography units gather clear, detailed images that are interpreted by our physicians and shared electronically with your doctor.

- **Dual-Energy X-ray Absorptiometry (DXA) Scan** – Bone fracture prevention is important to all women, but it’s especially critical to breast cancer survivors. A DXA scan measures bone loss – which can be caused by osteoporosis – using an x-ray generator and an imaging device. For your convenience, our team suggests scheduling your mammogram and DXA scan during a single appointment at the Breast Care Center.
- **Ductogram** – Using this imaging technique, Breast Care Center physicians can learn the cause of specific symptoms or locate a mass within the breast’s ductal system.
- **Fine Needle Aspiration** – During this exam, a physician removes fluid from a mass in the breast or lymph node for diagnosis by a pathologist in the hospital’s laboratory.
- **Stereotactic Biopsy** – This procedure allows physicians to gather breast tissue for diagnosis using computer guidance. Stereotactic biopsy eliminates the need for more invasive surgical biopsy.
- **Tomosynthesis** – This diagnostic tool creates a three-dimensional image of the breast, which allows physicians to take a closer look at tissue. Breast tomosynthesis helps reduce the number of false positive results, repeat screenings and additional tests.

Our Clinical Navigators Undergoing medical tests of any kind can be unsettling and worrisome. That's why the Breast Care Center includes two clinical navigators. These specially trained and highly experienced registered nurses guide, educate and counsel patients. Our clinical navigators help patients through testing, diagnosis and treatment options, providing emotional support and information every step of the way.

Guiding You . . . Our Consultation Services

A breast cancer diagnosis can be overwhelming. That's why our highly trained clinical team is available to guide anyone diagnosed with breast cancer through that journey.

The Breast Care Center team works with community-based oncologists, surgeons, treatment facilities and The

Infusion Center at Dignity Health, YRMC East to meet patients' needs. Our radiologists, clinical navigators, nurses and other healthcare professionals live and work in our communities. 
Our team – including our clinical navigators – can help you:
