Infection Control

Many volunteers are responsible for cleaning equipment, wiping down staxi chairs, etc. We wanted to offer a quick reminder to ensure safety for you and for those we serve.

- When you disinfect an item, please always wear gloves.
- Always clean a staxi chair after each use to avoid possible cross contamination.
- Volunteers do *not* clean areas contaminated with body fluids.
- Wash your hands often.


Annabelle (on right) noticed that her ED partner, **Amelia's** (on left) lanyard was getting worn and she surprised her with a new one.
